
Federally insured credit unions offer a safe place for you to save your money, with deposits insured up to at least \$250,000 per individual depositor by the National Credit Union Share Insurance Fund (NCUSIF). The NCUSIF protects members against losses if a federally insured credit union should fail. Like the FDIC's Deposit Insurance Fund, the NCUSIF is a federal insurance fund backed by the full faith and credit of the United States government.

Deposits at all federal credit unions, and the vast majority of state-chartered credit unions, are covered by NCUSIF protection. Not one penny of insured savings has ever been lost by a member of a federally insured credit union.

How to Spot a Scam

- Scammers pretend to be from an organization you know. Scammers often pretend to be contacting you on behalf of the government or a business you know, like a utility company, tech company, or charity.
- Scammers say there's a problem or a prize. Scammers might say you're in trouble with the government, or you owe money, or someone in your family had an emergency.
- Scammers pressure you to act immediately. Scammers want you to act before you have time to think and they may also threaten you.
- Scammers tell you to pay in a specific way. Scammers often insist you pay using cryptocurrency, through wire, or gift cards.

How to Avoid a Scam

- · Block unwanted calls and text messages.
- Don't give your personal or financial information in response to a request that you didn't expect.
- Resist the pressure to act immediately.
- · Know how scammers tell you to pay.
- Stop and talk to someone you trust.
