SPRING 2026 SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

Deadline for Completed Applications – March 13, 2026

(Awards to be announced in May 2026)

Big Island Federal Credit Union invites all its eligible members to apply for cash scholarship awards. A total of nine (9) awards (four at \$2,500 each and five at \$1,000 each) will be made as follows:

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicant must be a member in good standing of the Big Island Federal Credit Union.
- A member can win an award only once.
- Only one award per immediate family per year.
- Applicant must be a Big Island FCU member prior to the deadline.
- Eligible applicants include:
 - Students who will be or are attending a two-year post-secondary institution of higher learning such as a community college or junior college.
 - Students who will be or are attending a four-year post-secondary institution of higher learning.
 - Students that have earned a baccalaureate degree on or before December 2025 and are pursuing or will pursue an advanced degree.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

Applications shall be reviewed and scored by the Scholarship Committee based on the following criteria.

It shall be the sole responsibility of the applicant to secure and submit all the required information and/or supporting materials. **Incomplete applications will NOT be considered.**

- A. **Academic Excellence:** Include your most recent official high school or post-secondary transcript.
- B. **List of Achievements:** List your top five achievements within the last four years in chronological order. These accomplishments may include honors, awards, leadership, and extracurricular school activities. Explain your participation in these activities and how each accomplishment benefited you.
- C. **List of Community Involvement:** List any community/volunteer involvement or service within the last four years. Explain your involvement and how it benefited you.
- D. **Statement of Academic and Career Goals:** Use one typed page to describe your goals clearly and to relate them to your current academic pursuits.

Include some discussion of any factors (such as family standing, employment, and responsibilities) that impact on the pursuit of your academic goals.

- E. **Recommendations:** Submit two recommendations from teachers, counselors, professors, or employers who are familiar with your record. Please include a typed statement of the applicant's personal and academic focus, qualities, and promise.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Obtain application packet from the Hilo, Keaau, or Kona office of the Big Island Federal Credit Union.
2. Complete application form.
3. Obtain OFFICIAL transcript.
4. List and describe achievements.
5. List and explain community involvement.
6. Write personal statement of goals.
7. Give recommendation forms and envelopes to your references. Arrange to pick up completed forms to submit with your application form. Include names and telephone numbers of references on application form.
8. Submit in person or mail completed application, transcript, list of achievements, statement of goals, and sealed recommendations to:
